2. In what ways does John describe the magnificence of the New Jerusalem? (See Revelation 21:9-14; 18-21)
3. What is your response when you read John's description of its magnificence?
4. Read Revelation 21:15-17. What images come to mind when you think about the size of the New Jerusalem? Note also Jesus' words in John 14:2.
5. Read Revelation 7:9 and 5:11. What is your response when you read these verses?
6. When you consider that one third of the angels fell when Satan fell from Heaven, why is it vital for followers of Jesus to put on the full armour of God every day? (See Ephesians 6:10-12)
7. What is the greatest feature of the New Jerusalem? (See Revelation 21:3)
8. Why must we make sure our names are written down in the Lamb's Book of Life? (See Revelation 21:27)
9. What is your response to John's words in Revelation 22:1-5?
