 - (a) What's yours is mine and I'm going to take it.
 - (b) What's mine is mine and I'm going to keep it.
 - (c) What's mine is yours and I'm going to give it.

8. Which of the three attitudes is the correct one for true followers of Jesus?
9. According to Jesus' teaching in this parable, who is your neighbour?
10. What practical and personal things can you do to reach out to your "neighbours"?
